NOTES:

This list is not quantitative. i.e., there may be one specimen or more of each species listed.

Also, due to ongoing research and categorization, scientific names are subject to change.

While there are many large and mature specimens on display, due to the relative young age of our Botanical Garden, many species on display are still younger and are being trialed in North Florida for the first time.

Some are succeeding and growing rapidly and seem to be adapting well to our microclimate. Others appear to be surviving but not rapidly growing. And some will undoubtedly not survive here. However, some of our palms will not survive in South Florida but may do well here. Therefore, we are the “tip of the spear,” so to speak, in terms of the northern extent of many tropical palms and other species, but also in a unique climate that allows us to test those species unable to survive farther south. Most palms are planted but several palms are on display in pots only because we have determined that they are too cold sensitive for our area and we move them to protected areas in the winter, as do many other botanical gardens in North America.

But testing is the only way we can learn. It is hoped that the research done here will improve the chances of survival of many species, increase the awareness of the general public about palms, and contribute to the use of water conserving, fertilizer sparing, disease resistant, cold tolerant palms.

Finally, the conservation status of many palms is constantly fluctuating, and this list does not label every species that is threatened or endangered as the list is continually changing. Suffice it to say, sadly many species of palms worldwide are threatened or endangered due to habitat destruction and the introduction of invasive species. ***That is why the collection of palm species, like that in the SJBGNP is so important, not just for educational purposes but for their conservation.***
